# UCONN Avery Point Awards 2008

## Awards of Excellence

These scholarships are based on academic talent and performance, and/or service to the Avery Point community and the community at large.

### To be considered:

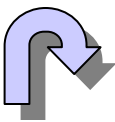
- ❖ You must be a **degree-seeking undergraduate** UConn - **Avery Point** student
- ❖ You must have completed a minimum of 12 credits at the University of Connecticut at **Avery Point**
- ❖ You must have enrolled at **Avery Point** in a minimum of two courses during the fall term and two during the spring term of the academic year in which the scholarships are awarded.
- ❖ You must have a cumulative minimum GPA of 2.0, and a fall semester minimum GPA of 2.0.
- ❖ You must continue to attend the University of Connecticut (at Avery Point or another UConn campus) in the fall semester. Scholarships are payable as fee credit at the University of Connecticut, credit to be applied toward fees for the subsequent fall semester at the University, but not payable to cover summer session fees.

## Southeastern Chapter Alumni Scholarships

Criteria for the alumni scholarships include academic achievement and service to the community, particularly the Avery Point community. Scholarships will be awarded to **Coastal Studies**, **Maritime Studies**, or **American Studies** majors, at Avery Point.

### To be considered:

- ❖ You must be a full-time, degree seeking undergraduate UConn **Avery Point** student who will again be a full-time University of Connecticut student at **Avery Point** in the fall semester.
- ❖ Students must have demonstrated financial need as determined by the University financial aid procedures (based on the Free Application for Federal Student Aid).



## **Application procedures for Awards of Excellence and Southeastern Chapter Alumni Scholarships**

The awards committees will offer 0-12 scholarships in any given year. There is no set monetary amount attached to any award. Students do not need to be nominated by a faculty member in order to apply.

### **1. Fill out the application and attach an essay, 2 pages typed double space that addresses one of the following topics:**

- ❖ Your educational goals
  - ❖ Your academic achievement or talents
  - ❖ Your service to Avery Point and the community
- Evidence of remarkable improvement or obstacles overcome may be included.***

### **2. Provide 2 letters of recommendation**

- ❖ At least one letter must be from an Avery Point instructor
- ❖ The person writing the recommendation should be knowledgeable about your academic achievements, contributions in the classroom, or service activities
- ❖ Inform the person writing on your behalf that the letter of recommendation is due on or before **Friday, March 7.**

Attached is a form to be used by the recommending faculty member. It is your responsibility to follow up with the professor to see if he/she has submitted the form to the Student Affairs Office by the deadline of March 7.
